Spanish Grease Tour

The soulful style and hard-hitting beats grab you first, followed by the smooth yet powerful baritone voice of Kemo The Blaxican – former member of urban-Latin hip hop pioneers Delinquent Habits. Switching effortlessly between English and Spanish, Kemo delivers provocative lyrics over tracks inspired by Southern California culture, blending west coast funk, soul, classic hip hop and traditional Latin influences.

His album *Upside of Struggle* features guest appearances by Sen Dog (Cypress Hill), Sick Jacken (Psycho Realm) and Tetsuya “Weeping Willow” Nakamura (formerly of War). The record showcases Kemo’s evolution as both MC and producer, moving between L.A. street slang and barrio Spanish while telling stories of struggle, identity and survival.

Before going solo, Kemo spent twelve years with Delinquent Habits, helping shape the Latin hip hop movement and worldwide hit “Tres Delinquentes.” After touring across Europe, Japan, South America and beyond, he launched a successful solo career through his indie label Dead Silence Records, releasing albums including *Simple Plan*, *Not So Rich & Famous* and *Upside of Struggle*.

Known for his raw style, bilingual flow and genre-crossing sound, Kemo The Blaxican continues to push Latin hip hop forward with authenticity, soul and unmistakable energy.
